SHARING THE LOVE OF JESUS

This month brings with it some pinnacle holidays in the Church calendar. Below is listed a schedule for you to refer to as you plan your own calendar. This morning as I was browsing the news stories I came across one about a Methodist pastor in North Carolina who had recently been fired. Guess what unsavory wicked act he had committed. Messing around with prostitutes? No. Drinking on the job? No. Skimming off the tops of the offering plates? No. His crime was that he agreed with Rob Bell's statement that maybe there is enough love in God's heart that no one is damned to an eternity in hell. He had the gall to say that God may have enough grace, love and mercy within who God is to make it possible, somehow, for people, even in the afterlife, to atone for their sins without being forever cast from God's presence.

What I am not going to do is say one position is right and the other wrong. I am not so arrogant as to believe that I can know the limits of what God will or will not do. I leave those kinds of things up to God. What blew me away was that those who fired him are pretty sure they know what God thinks. They know that they are going to Heaven and there are lots of people who won't be joining them there. This is the kind of press that makes Christians look bad. I was embarrassed for the image non-Christians see when they read this kind of thing. Jesus was more interested in getting people on the right track than he was in damning them. He was more concerned with reconciliation than retribution. Wouldn't it be wonderful if all Christians today focused more on the question, "How can I spread the message that God loves people so much that he died on the cross for us?" rather than the question, "Ok, let's figure out who is in (me) and who is out (everyone who disagrees with me) when it comes to Heaven?"

As we approach the most holy of days, Easter, we should refocus not only on John 3:16, but John 3:17 as well. I'm glad to be a part of our community of faith that works to **SHARE THE LOVE OF JESUS** rather than spreading our own prejudices and playing God ourselves! Thanks for being the loving, graceful people you are!
