At the end of this next month we will be one quarter of the way through 2011. I don't know about you but this year has felt different to me. Not necessarily in a bad way, just kind of weird. Maybe it has to do with the fact that Easter is very late this year and we preachers have had Scripture lessons that are different than the norm as Epiphany is so much longer. I think it also has to do with the fact that Kristin and I have been a part of this church now for enough years that I have come to recognize patterns that, for the most part, could be counted on. For example, we are getting ready for the Church season of Lent. One of the first things I think of in preparing for Lent is that I need to get a sign up sheet posted in the narthex for people to sign up who will be providing soup for our Wednesday evening soup suppers. Each year up until this year that was basically picking up the phone and asking Dr. Bob to print one up from the template he kept on his computer. But this year Randy did it because Dr. Bob is now in Heaven. I have come to know who I could count on to fill in the blanks of providing soup from our congregation. Each year Ruth Johnson would fill her name in in at least two spots. But someone else is going to have to step up because Ruth is now in Tulare. (Not exactly Heaven!) Since the beginning of the year we have had five funerals/memorial services. People are missing who I have been used to seeing on a regular basis because they have moved or died. I guess all of that leads to this weird feeling of strangeness. It's not necessarily bad, just different in a very familiar environment. I know some of you have felt the same way as you have shared your feelings with me.

It is at times like this that our community of faith is particularly important. As we have seen, life changes. Sometimes it changes very quickly. Sometimes those changes pile up and leave us wondering how we should be feeling. The one thing we know that is a constant is God. No matter what is going on we know God is in charge. In that I find a certain amount of freedom to accept the changes, as strange as they may seem, realizing I don't have to understand everything because I am not ultimately in charge. God is.

We do have an opportunity beginning with Ash Wednesday, March 9, and each Wednesday up until Holy Week, to gather together and have a meal and then a time to explore different aspects of our faith with the Wednesday Lenten Gatherings. It will start at 6:15 with dinner then we will meet in the Community Center at 7:00. If you are feeling like 2011 is a little "different" this can be something you can count on each week and maybe get your bearings back. And please, sign up to provide soup if you can! All of our churches could use more people like Ruth Johnson! Incidentally, if there is a week where no one has signed up by the Sunday prior to the upcoming Wednesday we will have a potluck dinner instead of the traditional soup supper.

I look forward to living out the rest of 2011 with you!

The 32nd Annual Brian Sturgeon St. Patrick's Day Run

The 32nd Annual Brian Sturgeon St. Patrick's Day Run and Walk for UCP, one of the longest term events of its kind in the Valley, is scheduled for Saturday, March 12th at Woodward Park in Fresno.

The event, which has become a Valley tradition, has raised more than \$300,000 for services to children and adults with Cerebral Palsy and other disabilities.

The adult 4 mile run is a premium 30 points in Race Director Ken Takeuchi's Valley Runner of the Year series.

In keeping with the Irish theme, the Run - Walk is now accompanied by a fund-raising arm called the Pot O Gold Committee.

UCP's objective is "Life Without Limits" for persons with disabilities. Awards include medallions hand made by UCPCC's adult students in the Arts and Technology Program.

At one time doctors questioned whether Brian, namesake of the event, would ever be able to walk. He RAN 9 miles in the early years of the Run, as participation grew from a handful to last year's 900. Brian, a torchbearer for the 2002 Winter Olympics, now tools around in a snappy convertible.

Races are scheduled for some of the Valley's top runners along with kids races and a walk for the more casual adults and family groups.

Starting times for the Kids Runs are 7:15 am, 7:25 am and 7:30 am. Starting times for the adults are 7:45 am for the 2 Mile Walk/Run and 8 am for the 4 Mile.

Entry fees are \$10 for kids and \$20 for adults until March 10th, and \$25 on Race Day. In person registration and pre-registration packet pick-ups are scheduled for March 9th, 10 am - 7 pm at the Sierra Running Company at 9447 North Fort Washington, #106 at Friant Road, Fresno, in the Riverview Shopping Center.
